THANK GOD IT'S MONDAY

You've heard about the guy who is such a workaholic that he has a plaque in his office that says, "Thank God it's Monday!"

Well, as we have a reason to say that. The fact is, we spend most of our lives working—more time is spent at the office than anywhere else. And we can be sure of this: when we work, we are doing more than earning a paycheck. We are serving God. It doesn't really matter what type of work we do; any labor can be offered as a sacrifice to God. Paul told all people to do their work "heartily", as if they were working for God, rather than men. (Colossians 3:23)

We have an additional promise to claim. Paul said: "Your labor in the Lord is not in vain." Though at times we may feel like we are spinning our wheels—and results seem few and far between—we have God's assurance that the work we offer to him will bear fruit.

The results of our service may sometimes be out of the field of our vision, but they are never out of the field of God's vision. He sees what we do; he doesn't miss a thing. Our labor is not in vain. That's his promise.
